**Sub:** Conversion of existing UG Programmes in Three Majors to Single Major from the Academic Year 2023-2024 –Meeting with Principals, IQAC Coordinators and subject Experts from NRCs – communication of Schedule – Reg.

**Ref:** Lr.No.APSCHE/AC/CBCS-2019-20/Review from the Secretary, APSCHE, Mangalagiri dated:24-04-2023.

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It is to inform that the AP State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) revised the Curricular framework of General UG Programmes in accordance with NEP 2020 and Revised Curricular Structure of UGC. The major change in the proposed curriculum is a shift from three majors to single majors along with multiple entry and exit options. It is further informed that the Secretary, APSCHE in his letter cited in the reference, requested the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, AP to initiate the process of conversion of three majors into single majors in all Government Degree Colleges to be in effect from 2023-24.

In this connection a meeting is arranged on conversion of existing UG Programmes in Three Majors to Single Major from the Academic Year 2023-2024 with **Principals, IQAC Coordinators and Subject Experts from the Government Degree Colleges mapped to the following NRCs as per the schedule given below:**



## **GUIDELINES**

**(Annexure to Procds RC.No.2/CCE – Acad.Cell/Sing.Maj/AC-06/2022 of  
the CCE-AP Dated: 24 .05.2023.)**

The existing three majors programmes offered by the Government Degree Colleges (GDCs) are to be converted into single major programmes from the academic year 2023-24 invariably.

The process of conversion of three majors into single majors in all GDCs& that of the aided sections of the PACs is as follows:

- a. The colleges can opt to convert each existing three majors UG programme with sanctioned intake of 40 or below to another single majors UG programme with same or lesser intake with a minimum of 25 intake, provided that the admissions for the existing three majors programme have been  $\geq 30\%$  on average for the last three academic years i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23.
- b. The colleges can opt to convert each existing three majors UG programme with sanctioned intake of 41 to 59 to two single majors UG programmes with half the sanctioned intake for each of the new single majors, with a minimum of 25 intake, provided that the admissions for the existing three majors programme have been  $\geq 75\%$  on average for the last three academic years i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23.
- c. The colleges can opt to convert each existing three majors UG programme with sanctioned intake of 60 and above to two single majors UG programmes with half the existing sanctioned intake for each of the two new single majors, with a minimum of 25 intake, provided that the admissions for the existing three majors programme have been  $\geq 50\%$  on average for the last three academic years i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23.
- d. In case of (b) and (c) above, where the admissions criteria are not met, the existing three majors UG programme can be converted to another single majors UG programme with same or lesser intake with a minimum of 25 intake, provided that the admissions for the existing three majors programme have been  $\geq 30\%$  on average for the last three academic years i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23.

- e. In case of any UG programme that does not fall in the above categories i.e. the existing UG programmes with less than 30% on average for the last three academic years i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23 cannot be converted and shall be discontinued deeming unviable.

For instance,

Case-I. The existing UG programme - B.Sc. (MPC) with  $\leq 40$  intake and with  $\geq 30\%$  three year average admission percentage can be converted to:

- i. B.Sc. Honours (Mathematics) with 25 to 40 intake  
(or)
- ii. B.Sc. Honours (Physics) with 25 to 40 intake  
(or)
- iii. B.Sc. Honours (Chemistry) with 25 to 40 intake

Case-II. The existing UG programme - B.Sc (MPC) with 41-59 intake and with  $\geq 75\%$  three year average admission percentage can be converted to:

- iv. B.Sc. Honours (Mathematics) with 25-30 intake and B.Sc Honours (Physics) with 25-30 intake  
(or)
- v. B.Sc. Honours (Mathematics) with 25-30 intake and B.Sc Honours (Chemistry) with 25-30 intake  
(or)
- vi. B.Sc. Honours (Physics) with 25-30 intake and B.Sc Honours (Chemistry) with 25-30 intake  
(or)
- vii. B.Sc. Honours (Mathematics) with 25-30 intake and any other Single Majors related to Mathematics/Physics/Chemistry with 25-30 intake

Case-III. The existing UG programme - B.Sc. (MPC) with  $\geq 60$  intake and with  $\geq 50\%$  three year average admission percentage can be converted as in (iv), (v), (vi) and (vii) with minimum intake of 30 or with half the existing sanctioned intake, for each of the two new single majors.

Case-IV. The existing UG programme - B.Sc (MPC) with 41-59 intake and with 30% to 74% three year average admission percentage (or) with  $\geq 60$



intake and with 30% to 49% three year average admission percentage can be converted into

- viii. B.Sc. Honours (Mathematics) with 30/half the existing intake (or)
  - ix. B.Sc. Honours (Physics) with 30/half the existing intake (or)
  - x. B.Sc. Honours (Chemistry) with 30/half the existing intake
- f. Conversion of existing three major programmes under Science disciplines can be done to FYUGPs (Hons/Research) under Science disciplines and the conversion of existing three major programmes of Arts stream can be done to FYUGPs (Hons/Research) under Arts disciplines only.
- g. Programmes like B.Com, B.Com (CA), BBA, BCA, B.Voc etc. can be continued with the same or modified intake as the programmes are already considered single majors. However, they will become Honours UG programmes due to revised curricular framework that of the Four Year UG Programmes (FYUGPs) to be implemented from the academic year 2023-24. Such FYUGPs are continued with the existing or modified (as per the request of the college) intake with a minimum of 30 intake provided that the admissions for the existing three majors programme have been  $\geq 30\%$  on average for the last three academic years i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23. Otherwise, the programme is deemed unviable and cannot be converted onto FYUGP and the college can propose for restructured programmes in commerce.
- h. The new FYUGP proposed must be offered by the affiliating University/SSCs under NSQF.
- i. Sanction is subject to the availability of Sanctioned Posts for the subjects required to teach the proposed new FYUGP's major as per SMPC, Laboratories, Classrooms, and necessary Infrastructure.

All single majors will be offered in English Medium in accordance with G.O Ms.No.49 HE(CE) Dept Dt:16.09.2021.

2.Minutes of the meeting held on 28-04-2023.

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The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE) is striving to enhance Employability skills of student as part of the implementation of Revised Curriculum Framework:2020 in UG programs in line with National Education Policy: 2020 (NEP:2020). CCE has planned to introduce certificate courses, which are not part of the Curriculum to empower the students and to enhance employability skills in students of GDCs. In this connection SGBS Unnati Foundation (SUF) has come forward with a proposal and the society of JKC undertaken a Memorandum of Understanding with Unnati Foundation to Prepare and empower the students of GDCs under UNXT Program by Training on Spoken English, Computers, Life Skills, Values and after successful completion of course and assessment certificates are to be issued.

**Unnati "UNXT" Program:**

1. Will conduct the UNXT training for 3 hours per batch per day, spanning over 30 working days in each GDC.
2. Will provide access to an e-learning app with over 600 videos and questions to the youth who attend the UNXT program.
3. Will provide a UNXT digital certificate to students who match the attendance requirement of 90% (27 days of attendance).
4. SUF will assure a job for students who approach them. The jobs will be in Metro Cities and in reputed companies with social securities like ESI & PF.
5. The salaries offered by these companies will be in line with the market.
6. SUF will collect data of students and will upload all relevant data onto NSDC portal.
7. Each Change Maker from SUF will conduct two batches per day and each batch of 35-45 final year students.

In view of the above, this is to inform to execute the Unnati UNXT Training Program (Offline) in GDCs, for 3 hours per batch and a minimum of two batch per day, spanning over 30 working days in each college after the completion of SEM End examinations without causing any disturbance to students during the exams for final year students. Hence all Principals of GDC are instructed to nominate Unnati program coordinators to look after the day-to-day activity, implementation of the schedule and course module, the curricular transaction both classroom learning and e-learning and to provide all the necessary infrastructure to ensure smooth running of the training program. Infrastructure includes (i) a classroom and (ii) a Projector or a TV with Internet connection.
