# MUSHROOM CULTIVATION

### INTRODUCTION

It is well known that the 20th century was an explosive time for the accumulation of knowledge. Modern technology for human civilization is expanding every day. However, man is still facing three basic problems: shortage of food, pollution of the environment, and low quality of human health, due to the continued increase of the world population. The 20th century began with 1.6 billion people and ended with 6 billion inhabitants. The growing world population is increasing by about 80 million people per year. Inadequate regional food supplies, low quality of health, and increasing environmental deterioration are three key underlying problems affecting the future well-being of humankind. The magnitude of these problems is set to increase as the world's population continues to grow. There are other ways to subsidise the food problem and to increase the food productivity. One of the ways to enhance the food production or copup the food problem is mushroom culture.

Mushrooms are the fruiting bodies of macrofungi. They include both edible/medicinal and poisonous species. However, the word "mushroom" was used for the edible members of macrofungi and "toadstools" for poisonous ones. Scientifically the term "toadstool" has no meaning at all. It has been proposed in order to avoid confusion between terms edible, medicinal and poisonous mushrooms. Edible mushrooms once called the "food of the gods" and still treated as a garnish or delicacy can be taken regularly as part of the human diet or be treated as healthy food or as functional food. The extractable products from medicinal mushrooms, designed to supplement the human diet not as regular food, but as the enhancement of health and fitness. These are being classified into the category of dietary supplements/mushroom nutriceuticals.

Mushrooms are very nutritious products that can be generated from ligno-cellulosic waste materials; and are rich in crude fibre and protein. In fact, mushrooms also contain low fat, low calories and good vitamins. In addition, many mushrooms possess multi-functional medicinal properties.

The spent substrate left after harvesting the mushrooms, which is entangled with innumerable mushroom threads (collectively referred to as mycelia) will have been biochemically modified by the mushroom enzymes into a simpler and more readily digestible form, which is thus more palatable to livestock, when used as a livestock feed supplement. Additionally, it will significantly have been enriched with protein, by virtue of the remains of the protein-rich mycelia, left after harvesting the mushroom fruiting bodies. The residue could also be utilized as organic garden mulch, which is good for the soil.

Mushroom cultivation has great scope in China, India and in some of the other developing countries. Because, the cheap and easily available raw materials needed for this activity, coupled with faster means of communication and marketing (as a fresh commodity), and better purchasing power of the people. Since the cultivation of mushrooms deals with living organisms, one should consider, the mushroom itself, and of the various micro-organisms growing with it (including both the harmful and beneficial ones), but also the physical and biochemical natures of the substrates. Therefore, the cultivation methods must be tailored in accordance with the prevailing unique natural resources, heritage, local climate, and socioeconomic conditions of each farming community. All these considerations call for a critical mass of well trained mushroom scientists and mushroom growers.

The key objectives will be, firstly, to develop *Pleurotus* (oyster) mushrooms as additional, highly nutritious vegetable crop. We should start with this because is easy to grow and they are also high in protein apart from medicinal qualities. A comprehensive training programme for both researchers and mushroom growers will need to be formulated. The identified team of researchers will be brought together for an intensive training course, which will equip them with more skills on how to train others, and also help them on how to succeed in this promising venture. Mushroom farming is both a science and an art. The science, in its broad form, will come through training workshops/courses. The art will come through practical involvement and experience, and will have to be modified in accordance with the prevailing conditions on site. The potential of mushroom farming in generating new employment opportunities is another positive element emanating from mushroom farming ventures, which can be labour intensive.

This programme will aim at providing initial skills for cottage level mushroom production. Later, large scale development can be expected to lead to the establishment of commercial mushroom farms, and international marketing ventures. Due to advances in both basic knowledge and practical technology relevant to mushroom farming (mushroom themselves), mushroom products (mushroom derivatives) and mushroom bioremediation (mushroom mycelia), these principles can be applied globally. Thus the training activities (workshops and

courses) need to be supported by Governments for providing self employment and development of entrepreneurship especially to the rural and downtrodden people.

A flower bouquet is a collection of flowers in a creative arrangement. Flower bouquets can be arranged for the decor of homes or public buildings, or may be handheld. Handheld bouquets are classified by several different popular shapes and styles, including nosegay, crescent, and cascading bouquets. Flower bouquets are often given for special occasions such as birthdays, anniversaries or funerals. They are also used extensively in weddings as well as Olympics Medal Ceremonies. Bouquets arranged in vases or planters for home decor can be arranged in either traditional or modern styles. Symbolism may be attached to the types of flowers used, according to the culture.

### Beach Wedding Bouquet

The arrangement of flowers for home or building decor has a long history throughout the world. The oldest evidence of formal arranging of bouquets in vases comes from ancient Egypt, and depictions of flower arrangements date to the Old Kingdom (~2500 BCE). The sacred lotus was often used, as were herbs, palms, irises, anemones, and narcissus. In some cultures, ancient practises still survive today, for example in ikebana, the art of flower-arranging that comes from Japan. The oldest known book on flower-arranging is Japanese and dates from 1445. Simplicity and linear form are core features of ikebana, which has had a great influence on Western flower arranging since the late 19th century.

Flower-arranging as an art form was brought to Japan by Buddhist monks, who learned it while in China. In ancient China, flower-arranging developed into a highly refined art form, based on the principle that life is sacred, including the life of plants, therefore <u>cut flowers</u> were used sparingly in carefully planned arrangements. Flowers were a traditional ritual offering among Buddhists, however, and remain so.<sup>[1]</sup> In Europe, flower arranging as a formal art was first documented among the Dutch, who "in particular, painted wonderful informal arrangements of flowers [...] In the 18th century, arrangements were used to decorate the houses of the wealthy families and the aristocracy."<sup>[2]</sup>

Flower symbolism is common in many cultures, and can be complex. In China, certain flowers symbolize seasons: white plum blossoms represent winter, peach and cherry blossoms represent spring, lotus represents summer, and chrysanthemums the fall.[1]

# Nosegay

Further information: Nosegay

The term "tussie-mussie" is sometimes used interchangeably with <u>nosegay</u>. A nosegay was also known as a "talking bouquet" or "flower poesy" during the <u>Victorian era</u>, when they became a popular gift. [3] Traditionally, <u>brides</u> will also carry a small nosegay. Tussie mussies were introduced to England in the early 18th century, and were a fashionable accessory for young women by the early 19th century. [4] A tussie mussie is a small circular bouquet like a nosegay, but carries symbolic meaning based upon the <u>language of flowers</u>, where particular flowers represent specific sentiments. They were commonly exchanged by lovers, who sent messages to one another based upon the flowers used in the bouquet. Traditionally, tussie mussies are arranged in a cone- or cornucopia-shaped container, made of tin or silver, with a chain attached for carrying the bouquet. [5]

# Language of flowers

Further information: Language of flowers

Flower symbolism originated in Asia and the Middle East, where certain flowers, such as the <u>lotus</u>, were considered sacred, or at least to be associated with spiritual themes. This was often reflected in artwork, for example the use of <u>bamboo</u> in Chinese art to represent longevity and eternity. The <u>language of flowers</u> was introduced to <u>England</u> in the early 18th century by <u>Mary Wortley</u>, Lady Montague, whose husband was Ambassador to <u>Turkey</u>. By the Victorian era, almost every flower had a specific meaning attached to it. Small <u>nosegay</u> or "tussie mussie" bouquets might include <u>chamomile</u> flowers, which a woman might send to a romantic interest to tell him "Patience"; <u>goldenrod</u> represented indecision.

# Wedding bouquets

Traditionally the <u>bride</u> will hold the bouquet, and the <u>maid of honor</u> will hold it during the ceremony. After the wedding the bride will toss it over her shoulder, and it is believed that whoever catches the bouquet is the next in line to be married. This practice may be related to the <u>Golden Apple of Discord</u> myth. Coldent Apple of Discord D

# **Wedding bouquet shapes**

There are many different bridal bouquet styles from which to select. Brides typically choose the shape of their bouquets according to popular trends at the time of their wedding; however, some choose bouquets which evoke another time period. While the language of flowers can contribute to a message to be conveyed about the couple, the shapes are a personal preference.

The Posy bouquet is typically round in shape and is thought of as modern due to the small size and relative simplicity of the arrangement. It is also popular for the ease of carrying and passing-off during the ceremony. It can be composed of an expensive flower, such as a rose, or can be a sampling of country flowers.


The Cascading bouquet is usually a large arrangement which tapers near the bottom. It was popularized as the arrangement of choice for the 1980s at the wedding of Lady Diana Spencer and the Prince of Wales at Westminster Abbey. It can, and is often, made up of many types of flowers and is enhanced with Baby's Breath and different types of greenery, such as ivy. This bouquet became less popular as bridal trends shifted towards simplicity; however, it has found a resurgence in recent years.

The Presentation bouquet saw a surge in popularity at the turn of the twentieth century. It is most frequently composed of a long-stemmed bud, such as the Calla Lily, and is cradled in the bride's arms, rather than carried by the stems.
